Dear Parents,

Unfortunately we need to report two confirmed cases of H1N1 today in Miss Freeman's Year 2 class. This is a student and Miss Freeman herself, both who are not attending school until they have recovered. We will check temperatures in this class and will send any children home with a temperature above 37.8 degrees Celsius.

We would remind you to be vigilant and check your child's temperature in the morning and only send your child to school if their temperature is below 37.8 degrees Celsius. We would also remind you that you will need to keep your child home if they have H1N1 symptoms. Please see Ministry of Health websites for latest information.

Any children kept home or sent home due to a temperature above 37.8 degrees Celsius and/or H1N1 symptoms may return to school after providing the school with written clearance from your child's doctor.

We appreciate the ongoing home-school partnership and everyone's actions in helping keep our school as healthy as possible during this time.

We also hope that anyone who is sick has good rest and recovers well especially in time to enjoy our upcoming holidays.
